It's the key to a scam they always think is a peacekeeping mission. Part of the scam says they don't have access to their money, that the mission is very dangerous. If your friend's girlfriend/future husband/wife asks you to do the following or exhibited this behavior, it's most likely a scam: Move to your private messaging page immediately after meeting you on Facebook or SnapChat or Instagram, or some dating or social media site. Often times deleted from the site met them right after they asked me to move to a private messaging siteProfesses I love you very quickly & seem to quote poems and lyrics, as well as my own kind of broken language, as he professes to love and devotion quickly. It has also been shown concern for the health and love of the family. They promise marriage promises as soon as they step away from the freedom they've asked you to take. He asks for money (transfers) and Amazon, iTunes, Verizon, etc. gift cards, medicine, religious practices, and leaves to come home, internet access, full work assignments, help his sick friend, get him into trouble or anything that sounds suspicious. The army provides all soldiers, including medical care and transportation for freedom. Believe me, I've been through it, I'm probably being conned. I'm just trying to show you examples that you'll most likely conned. Below is an email response I received after I sent my investigation to the U.S. government when I discovered I was cheating. I got this wonderful response back with lots of useful links on how to find and report the scammer. And how to learn more about Romance Scams.Right now also copies the image you've given and do a google image search, and you can hopefully see the pictures of the real person he's impersonating. It doesn't always work, and a little digging. If you find the real person you can direct a message to them and warn them that the image is being used for fraud. Good luck, and I'm sorry this is happening to you. please continue to read the government response I received below that is very informative. He contacted an email that was monitored by the U.S. Army Criminal Investigation Command. Unfortunately, this is a common problem. Provide that there is never a reason to send money to anyone who claims to be a soldier online. Ha Ha just talking to this person online, it's likely that you're not an American soldier at all. If this is a suspected fraudulent social media profile, please report it on the platform as soon as possible.
